SUMMARY OF AWARDS

- 3M Coach of the Year Award

Standards:

1. Eligible candidates must be a member of Biathlon Alberta.
2. Demonstrates respect for officials, opponents and parents while espousing a philosophy of fair play.
3. Demonstrates concern for all-round development of the athlete and instilling guidelines reflecting responsible conduct beyond the playing field.
4. Presents by example, a positive image of coaching.
5. Demonstrates the ability to improve the athletic performance of a team or individual.
6. Applies relevant training theory and coaching techniques

- Shell Canada Volunteer of the Year Award

Standards:

1. Significant contributions to the sport of Biathlon.
2. Nominations to include summary of individual's specific contributions to Biathlon Alberta.
3. Exemplifies the volunteer spirit.
4. Must be a member of Biathlon Alberta.

- ABC Official of the Year

Standards:

1. Must have significantly contributed to the officiating of Biathlon Alberta competitions.
2. Show respect to the rules and regulations of Biathlon while demonstrating a philosophy of fair play.
3. Nominations must be accompanied by a summary of the nominee's involvement as an official at Biathlon Alberta events.
4. Must be a member of Biathlon Alberta.

- Ruedi Setz Memorial Award

Standards:

1. Biathlete must have made a significant contribution to the sport of Biathlon.
2. Must have maintained exemplary standards of sportsmanship.
3. Must be a member of Biathlon Alberta, and an active competitor.
4. Member must be a resident of the Province of Alberta.
5. Nominations for this award shall be in the form of a letter giving a short biography of the nominee and information substantiating the nomination.
