Welcome to Camrose

The Camrose Ski Club is pleased to welcome visiting teams to Camrose. The 'stage is set' for a great Biathlon Race!

Located in the heart of rural Alberta, Camrose is considered by many as one of the most beautiful cities on the prairies. Camrose is a clean and healthy community that boasts an exceptional quality of life for both citizens and visitors. The city offers a wide variety of amenities for all ages through modern services, first class recreation facilities, and all-embracing cultural opportunities. With a population of 17,000 and a trading area population exceeding 100,000, the progressive growth, development, and diverse economy of Camrose have contributed to its recognition as "The Regional Centre" for east central Alberta.

Founded in 1911 by Scandinavian settlers with the name of Fram Ski Club, Camrose Ski Club is one of the oldest in Canada. In the early days, jumping was the event that drew the crowds as Stoney Creek Valley filled with up to 3,000 people coming to see the "daring Norwegian flyers." Based on the nordic specialties, cross country skiing, jumping, nordic combined, luge and biathlon, the Camrose Ski Club has produced high-level athletes including Olympians Justine Nordmo and Kari Engstad (cross country skiing - Lake Placid, 1932), Clarence and Irvin Servold (nordic combined - Cortina, 1956, and Squaw Valley, 1960), Carol Gibson (cross country skiing - Canmore, 1988) Glen Rupertus (biathlon - Canmore, 1988, Albertville, 1990, and Lillehammer, 1994), and David Leoni (biathlon - Torino, 2006). Camrose Ski Club was involved from the beginning in the development of biathlon in Alberta. The first Canadian Biathlon Championships in 1965 were won by Denis Sjolje of Camrose.

Today the **Camrose Ski Club** is a diverse outdoor activity and sports club. The club has running, mountain biking, road biking, triathlon and snowboarding, in addition to the traditional cross country skiing, biathlon, and luge programs.

Camrose Ski Club is proud to partner with the **University of Alberta, Augustana Campus**, home of the ***only collegiate biathlon program outside of Europe***. The Augustana Vikings' Coaching Staff and Athletes have represented Team Canada at the FISU games many times, recently competing in both the 2013 World University Games in Italy and the 2015 World University Games in Slovakia. Vikings Student-Athletes continue to share their biathlon passion expertise with the community by coaching youngsters in the Camrose Ski Club biathlon programs.

Offering a liberal arts-focused education on an intimate campus, Augustana continues to build its reputation for high quality teaching on a friendly, caring, residence-based campus. Augustana began its operations in 1911, when it was known as Camrose Lutheran College. In 2004, the Augustana Campus merged with the University of Alberta, granting four-year baccalaureate degrees in the arts and the sciences. Augustana continues to be a place where students matter, where teaching is regarded as a vocation, and where community is an everyday experience.

Facilities

Camrose Shooting Sports/Biathlon Range

Directions to Camrose Biathlon Range: From Highway 13 (48th Avenue). Follow 48th Avenue to 50th Street, turn south (right), note that in a few blocks you will pass by the Augustana Campus on your left. Continue under the train trestle (1.2 km from the intersection of 48th Avenue and 50th Street, proceed about another kilometer and cross Hwy 13A (Camrose Dr.), and turn right at the T-intersection and proceed to the end of the road. The Camrose Shooting Sports/Biathlon Range is on the right hand side. Watch for signs. Waxing facilities are found at the Stoney Creek Centre. See map.

University of Alberta, Augustana Campus (Captains Meeting)

Directions to Campus: From Highway 13 (48th Avenue). Follow 48th Avenue to 50th Street, turn south (right). Proceed two blocks south and find Augustana Campus on your left.
