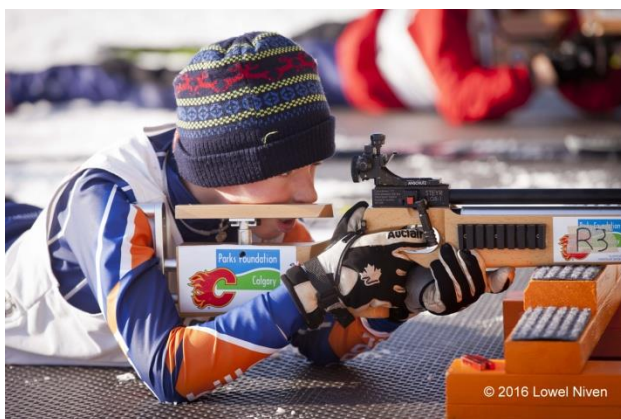


CANADIAN FIREARMS SAFETY COURSE



October 13 &
14, 2018



The Alberta Biathlon Club (ABC) is pleased to announce that it will again be offering the Canadian Firearms Safety Course (CFSC) to all athletes and/or parents/guardians of athletes enrolled in a Biathlon program in Alberta. All athletes 12 years of age or older require the CFSC to obtain their Minor Firearms License or if over 18 years of age a Possession and Acquisition License (PAL) in order to participate in the sport of Biathlon.

Who can attend: Any athlete who is **12 yrs or older on the date of the course**, parent, grandparent, and/or guardian involved in supporting an athlete in Biathlon or planning to join a Biathlon Club (includes Cadets) by September 2018. **Cost:** \$75 plus must be a current member of ABC (membership is \$5 per year). **Where:** Air Cadet School located at 607 - 7th Ave, **Canmore**, AB T1W 2H5. **When:** Saturday October 13, 9:30 AM to 4:00 PM & Sunday October 14, 9:30 AM to completion, instruction must be at least 8 hours by law, group size determines time required for testing on final day. **How to register:** online at <https://zone4.ca/register.asp?id=18886> Space is limited to 26 seats, so please register early.
