Participation

- Participation in this course is open to: coaches, officials, parents and athletes who utilize the CNCPP Biathlon Range on a regular basis.
- Participants must be a current member (2018/2019) of Biathlon Alberta (Biathlon Canada) and be a member of the club they are RSOing for. These memberships ensure the liability is covered and both are required for CNCPP.
- Participants must be 18 years of age, have successfully completed a Canadian Firearms Safety Course and possess a current unrestricted Firearms Possession and Acquisition License (PAL). Participants MUST have their PAL in hand and it cannot be expired.
- This is a Biathlon specific course and will not cover any other type of firearm.
- A maximum number of 15 individuals may participate in the session.
- Participants must commit to the full day in order to receive CNCPP RSO certification.
- If the course is full when you try to register, you will be placed on a wait list for the next available course.

Please ensure that you have materials you need to see at a distance and at close range. The course goes outside to the range several times during the day so appropriate footwear is important .
