## Lead biathlon coach for outreach programs

Biathlon Alberta is looking for multiple coaches who are interested in working in a biathlon introduction program within our sport partner groups. Biathlon Alberta has partnered up with Spirit North and Rocky Mountain Adaptive to offer and promote biathlon programs. Both programs have already existing nordic ski programs and the focus will be on introducing the shooting component within biathlon with eco-aims. Biathlon Alberta would consider splitting the programs between multiple coaches as long as the communication between coaches and the program delivery is ensured.

**Spirit North:** The majority of the sessions with Spirit North will run on Wednesdays out of the Canmore Nordic Centre. There is the potential of having more sessions at other locations within the Bow Valley. The sessions will run within the Spirit North Nordic ski program and the Spirit North coaches will also be present.

**Rocky Mountain Adaptive:** The majority of these sessions will also run out of the Canmore Nordic Centre on Saturdays with the potential of running more sessions if the demand is there. The RMA coaches and extra volunteers will be present at all sessions.

All coaches will have to run through a para-coaching-specific learning course by Nordiq Canada.

The total time commitment will be between 2-10hrs/week between January and March 2024. With the potential to extend the work after March 2024.
